Their primary strengths are safe easily navigated decks with a high guardrail that goes completely around the boat. Great sea-keeping qualities paired with very economical and reliable twin diesels. With her cruising speed of 7-8 knots you won't be water-skiing behind her but the more athletic members of the mackerel family may well find their way onto your fishing lines.
