Accommodation

6 Berths in 2 Cabins

Forward is the V-berth cabin which can convert into a larger double berth using the infill. There are lockers beneath the berth, a hanging locker port aft in the cabin and a vanity unit with a mirror and drawers and lockers beneath.

The forward head unit is starboard aft of the forward cabin. The head contains sea toilet and wash basin.

Next aft is the main saloon with a large u-shaped settee to starboard which converts into a double berth or two single berths. There are lockers located beneath the settee, four cave lockers behind the settee back and book shelves and lockers above. There is a large teak folding dining table to centerline.

To port in the main salon is a single settee which can also be used as a berth. There are lockers beneath, four cave lockers behind and book shelves and lockers above the berths. Forward of the port settee there is a double hanging locker. There is a cocktail cabinet and glass storage locker and sideboard aft.

The galley is to port aft of the main saloon and consists of a 2 burner cooker, oven and grill, twin stainless steel sinks, coolbox There is plenty of storage with a large locker beneath the sinks and worktops and shelving units above the worktops to outboard. Aft of galley is access to wet hanging locker with teak grate and sump.

The navigation station is located opposite the galley to starboard aft of the main saloon. The full size chart table has a chart stowage drawer and two lockers below. The navigation equipment is above the chart table.

Aft of the chart table is the full length pilot berth with good width.
