**Remarks :**

Izzeebee is a fabulous example of the Oceanis 331, a well respected model from the Beneteau yard offering comfortable accommodation and exhilarating performance. She has a very high specification as a 'Clipper' version with wheel steering, teak decks, additional halyard winch, detachable bowsprit and recently professionally fitted bowthruster.

As a lifting keel version, with twin rudders, she has a minimum draft of less than a metre offering versatility. The lifting keel is housed in a shallow stub wing keel. On drying out the hull rests on the three points of keel stub and twin rudder tips.

With her dark blue hull, matching sail bag and sprayhood Izzeebee looks the business. She has been lovingly maintained by her owners and is marina berthed and ready to sail.
