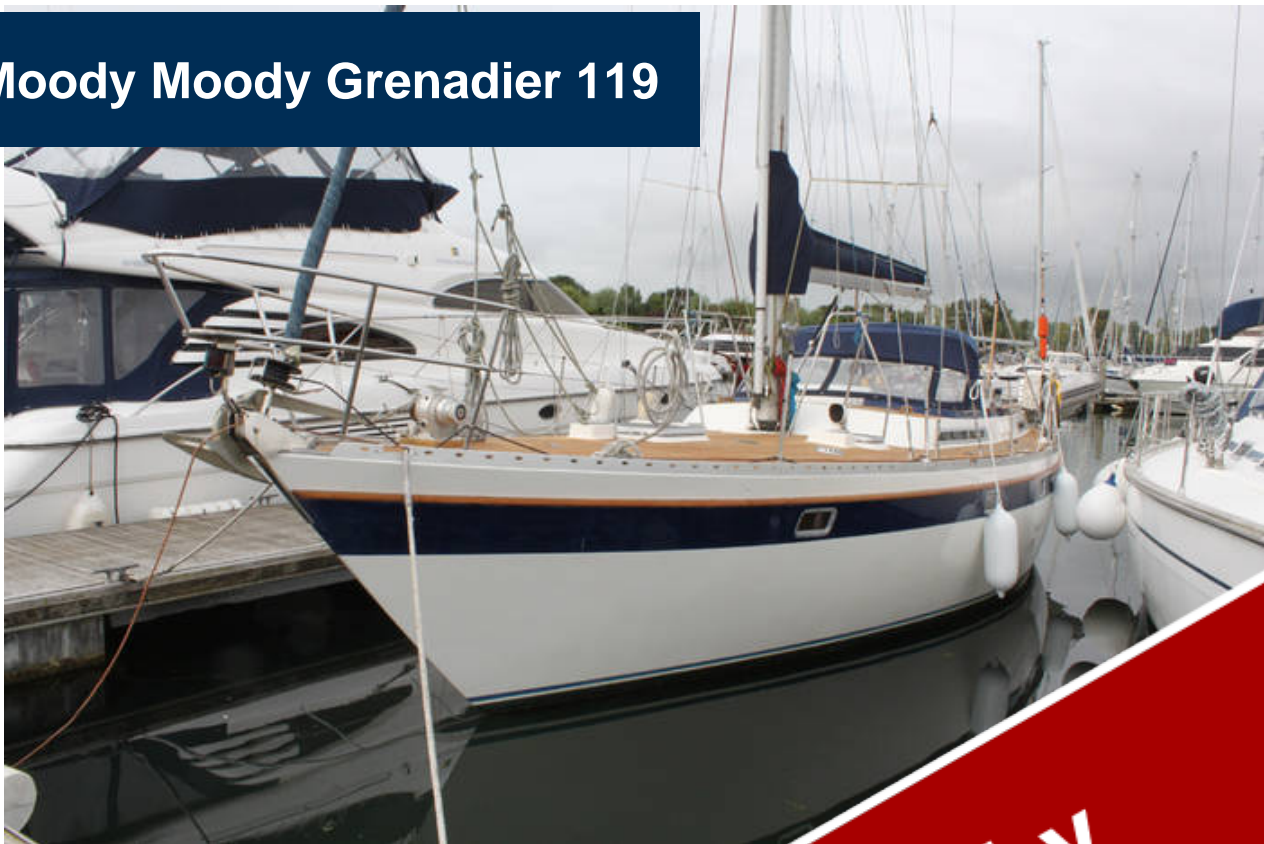


Moody Moody Grenadier 119

Remarks :

The Moody Grenadier 119 is an impressive powerful blue water cruising yacht. Encapsulated long keel with rudder and skeg centre cockpit and full teak decks. This is a very robust and seaworthy cruising yacht built to Lloyds 100 A1 specification. Moody only made a handful of them due to the cost of production so this is a rare opportunity to buy one of Moodys best boats.

The centre cockpit makes for a spacious interior and aft cabin making excellent use of the hull volume and her headroom is second to none. This particular Moody Grenadier benefits from being copper coated (2013), part 1 registered, cabin heating, bow thruster, radar, full teak decks, davits and lots more. For those looking to set sail for distant shores this is a must to consider.
