# CONSTRUCTION, MECHANICAL AND RIGGING

Built by Trident Marine (UK) Ltd in 1989 Designed by Bill Dixon

Hull # 069 Layout 'C' with owners cabin

- GRP hull, deck and superstructure
- Treated for osmosis in June 2004
- Solid teak laid side decks (Bucklers Hard Boat Builders)
- Solid teak laid cockpit (Bucklers Hard Boat Builders)
- 3/4 length encapsulated keel
- Wheel steering
- Skeg hung rudder
- Vetus 75KGF Bow thruster (2007), powered by 2 x 80 amp batteries in the forepeak
- Acrylic windows throughout (2010)
- Teak stowage rack to coach roof

#### **Mechanical:**

- Powered by a single Volvo D2-55 55hp 4-cylinder diesel engine (2012), engine bed (2012)
- Last serviced November 2016
- Fresh water cooled
- Approximately 300 hours running time to date
- Saildrive with aluminium propeller
- Single lever morse control
- Replacement engine instrument console with rev counter, oil pressure, AMPS, water temperature and fuel gauges
- Cruising speed under power 6.5 knots
- Maximum speed under power 8 knots
- Range 400 nautical miles

# ACCOMMODATION

Sleeps 6 in 2 double and two single berths in 4 cabins

- 6'6" headroom throughout
- The interior is finished in satin varnish with cream upholstery (2009), carpets and curtains
- Stainless steel washboard grills to leave boat locked but aired
- Access to cabin sole for extra stowage

Trident Warrior 40 built by Trident Marine. Owners cabin. A substantial offshore cruising yacht with 3/4 length encapsulated keel, cutter rigged with rigging replaced in 2013. The spinnaker gear and pole are on the mast and a spinnaker is included. A stack pack and lazy jacks were installed in 2013. Mainsail cover and spray hood are included. All the winches are Lewmar 2 speed. The hull was treated for osmosis in 2004. There is generous accommodation for six with the owner's en-suite cabin forward, a further double (which contains the navigation station) and a twin cabin. A huge inventory on this very well

equipped vessel which has had just about every conceivable update made in recent years, and ready to sail away.
