Accommodation

Accommodation

From the bow:

Fore cabin with 2 single berths converts to a double.
Forward heads marine toilet, washbasin and shower with hot and cold water.
Forward guest cabin to port with two single bunk berths, hanging locker and dressing table.

Saloon with two 'L' shaped contoured settee berths port and starboard. Large folding dining table.

Galley aft of the saloon on the port side and is separated from the saloon by a semi bulkhead.

'U' shaped galley arrangement with Neptune Plastimo cooker, large Isotherm (2008) top opening fridge, hot and cold water and storage.

Navigation centre opposite the galley on the starboard side with large chart table and all electronics.

A passageway, fitted with lockers and hanging space, leads to the owner's stateroom. Large fore and aft double berth fitted, an 'L' shaped upholstered corner seat and hanging locker and dressing table are complemented by an en-suite heads with manual toilet and shower. Divertor valve to holding tank.

An Eberspacher D4L provides heating with outlets to fore and aft cabins and saloon.

Remarks :

1986 MOODY 419 yacht for sale. 'White Knight of Burnham' is an excellent example of these spacious, comfortable and fast offshore cruisers. Besides the extra security at sea of a centre cockpit, she had a new Yanmar engine in 2005 and also boasts Hydrovane wind steering. With generous accommodation - large master cabin aft, with en-suite heads, two bunks in the port forward cabin plus a forward double - and a very full inventory, White Knight is worth an early viewing and careful consideration. *All serious offers will be considered!* See her at Titchmarsh Marina, viewing by appointment.
