Centre cockpit with sprayhood, Lofrans electric windlass, and 35lb CQR anchor. Spacious saloon with U-shaped settee, well-equipped galley, and two cabins with ensuites. Navigation area with VHF and radar. Epoxied hull, fin keel, and antifouled
