## Accommodation

Teak interior with a teak and holly sole.

Twin aft cabins with double berths, hanging lockers, shelves and opening portholes at the side of the coachroof and into the cockpit.

Forward cabin with a double berth, hanging locker, wash hand basin, lockers and opening deck hatch.

U-shaped saloon seating to starboard, saloon table can convert into double berth. Folding seat at the inboard side of the table, three opening deck hatches and two fixed hull ports.

Eberspacher Airtronic heating with timer

Linear galley to port with double stainless steel sinks, mixer tap, "Sidmer" fridge/ice box, "Eno" gas cooker with two burners and oven. Electric kettle, toaster, crockery, cutlery, pots and pans.

Clock, barometer and hydrometer.

Forward facing chart table to starboard with electrics panel, storage and opening porthole at the side of the coachroof.

Heads, shower and washbasin opposite to port with an opening porthole at the side of the coachroof.

Pressurised hot and cold water system with drinking water filter to separate tap.

Water heated by the engine and **shorepower**
